70% less energy is needed to recycle paper as opposed to making it from raw materials.

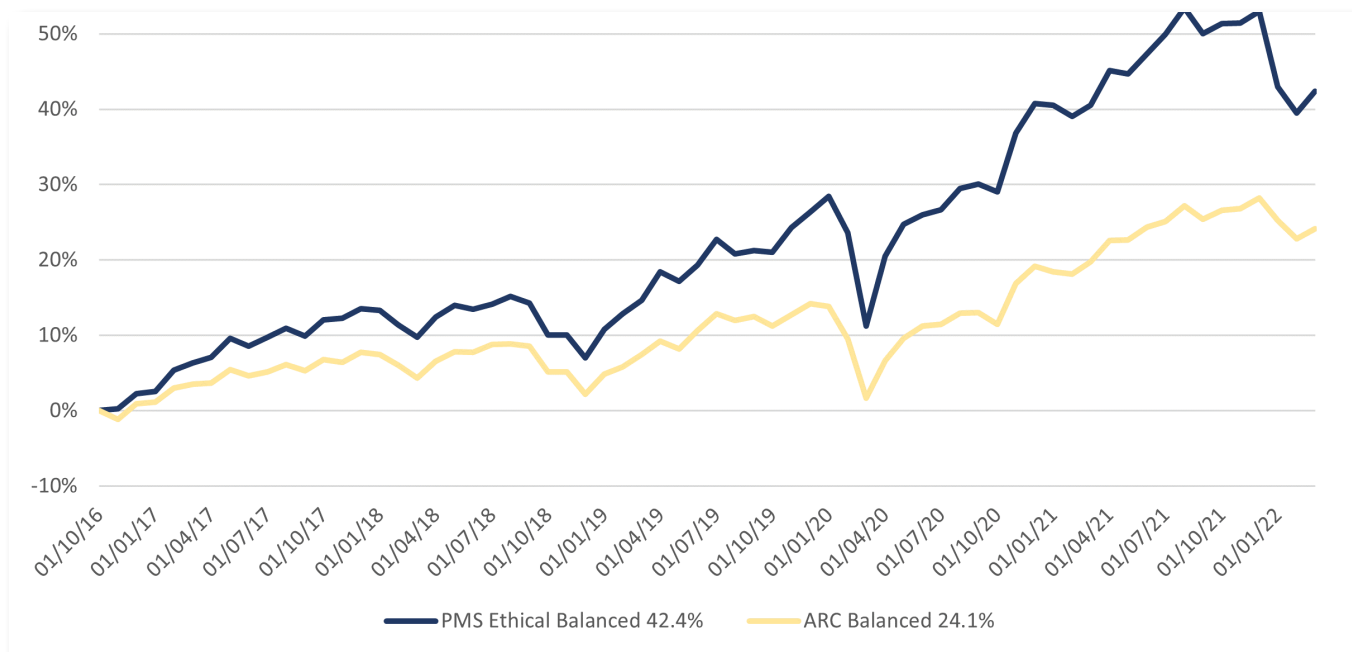
